



Special COVID Safety Info for Teams and Spectators

As most of you know how to be COVID-Safe already, we will just tell you the special things you need to know about Chalice and COVID-Safety. Flaming Chalice will be operating under the *Indoor Sports Industry Plan*.

Entry Conditions

- As usual, we expect you to comply with State Government health guidelines (stay home when sick, socially distance, good hygiene practices, etc)
- Everyone MUST fill in the electronic attendance register on arrival at each venue, each day. We will be using the Check In Qld App. Please allow a little extra time when you first arrive.
- Show your completed check-in to a COVID Safety Officer on entry, and throughout the day if asked.

Match Schedule

- An *additional 10 minutes* has been scheduled between each game to allow for cleaning, and for the playing teams to depart the playing area. Please do not start warming up for your game until the last duty team is finished sanitising.

Spectators

- Spectators will be allowed inside the venues, subject to maximum capacity and *provided that social distancing is maintained*. Chalice staff have the right to ask you to move, or leave, if they deem it necessary.
- Due to limited spectator capacity, NO spectator seating will be provided – your own chairs will not be allowed either. Spectators are asked to either stand, or sit on the floor while inside the venue.
- Mezzanine areas at Redlands and The Gap will be closed to spectators.
- We believe this strikes a balance between ensuring safety and allowing people to watch.

Sanitiser

Sanitiser will be provided at the entrance, at the venue office, and at scoring desks. Please use as often as needed.

When playing a game

- Remember to avoid direct contact with others where possible. At the end of the game, please touch elbows, or fist bump, instead of a handshake.
- Other than that, while on court you can warmup and play mostly as normal.

Duty Team Requirements

General

- Each official will need to provide their own equipment (whistles etc).
- Line judges to use hand signals only (no flags).
- While pens will be provided, it is suggested that scorers use their own.

End of Match Sanitisation

The duty team is expected to complete this process. Failure to do so may result in up to penalty points being applied.

The *Scorer* is responsible for sanitising:

- Score-Flips or Scoreboard remote
- Pen(s)
- Score benches
- Scorer's chair(s)

The *1st Referee* is responsible for sanitising:

- Post Pad (1st Referee side)
- Referee stand and pads
- Match Ball

The *2nd Referee* is responsible for sanitising:

- Post Pad (2nd Referee side)
- Volleyball net bands (top and bottom 'tape')

Cleaning equipment will be provided for each court. Please use spray on paper towel and apply all over surface, and leave to dry for 10 minutes.

A reminder list will be provided on the scorer's desks.
